Due NLT March 30<sup>th</sup> Min.-Max.: 2,000 - 2,500 Words

Your **ESSAY** is key! You should give this thoughtful consideration. The Focus Points below are offered only to prompt your thinking. The Focus Points are **not** intended as an outline.

Use your ESSAY to tell your story. It's your life; what are you doing with it? How well can you tell your story? What makes you different? What makes you jump off the page?

**Character** is often highlighted in times of crisis and during Presidential Elections. You are now at the doorstep of higher education. What have you learned that will make you successful at MSU; and at good citizenship after MSU?
